

Camp Rules

1. All campers that drive themselves will turn their keys into the Camp Director or to their Lion in Charge who will then turn keys into Camp Director.
2. Campers that come to camp on YMCA or Lions sponsored transportation will return on that same transportation unless a signed parental note indicates otherwise.
3. Campers will be on time to all camp functions.
4. Lights out and curfew is at midnight. No camper is allowed outside of their cabin after that time.
5. There will be no rock throwing.
6. Campers are not allowed to vandalize the camp property in any way - including but not limited to the following – graffiti, throwing rocks at cabins, etc.
7. Campers are not allowed to go to the waterfront without adult supervision.
8. No drinking or use of illegal drugs.
9. No smoking
10. No use of bad language
11. No fires may be built or lit.

Consequences

-Campers breaking any of these rules can be sent home immediately at their parent's expense. Parents and the Sponsoring Lions Club will be notified.

-Any damage to camp will have to be paid for by the campers. Parents, or sponsoring Lions Club

-Any campers breaking any of these rules can be isolated from the rest of camp until parents can be notified and the situation reconciled.

The Camp Director will go over these rules at the opening assembly. Each Lion will go over these rules and also establish cabin or group rules for the weekend at the opening Cabin Meeting Friday night at 7:30p.m.
